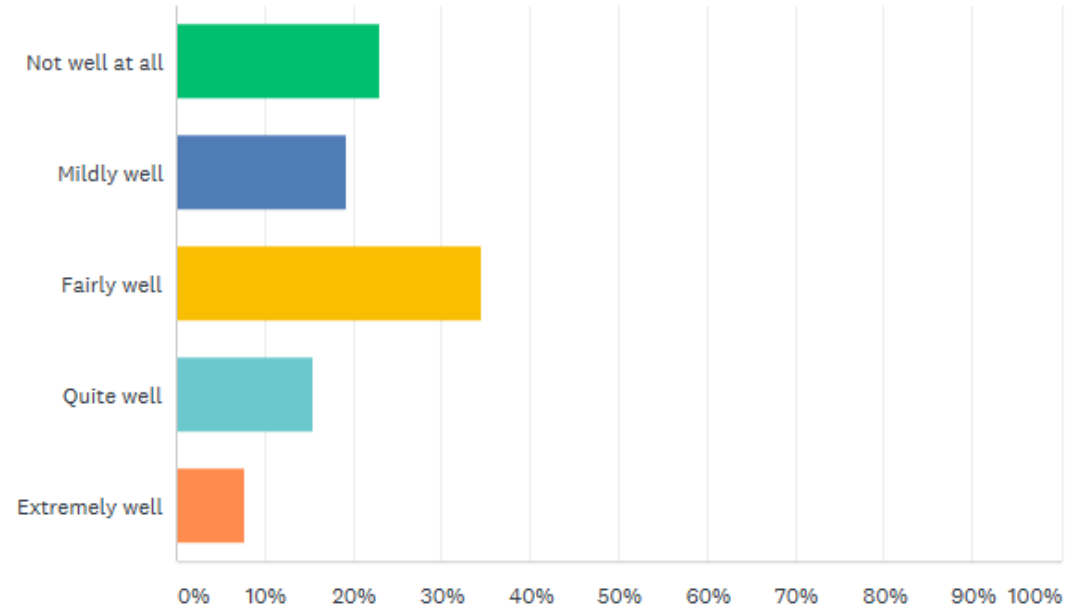


# PCNC Parent Survey

# How well do you know your child's Principal and Teachers?

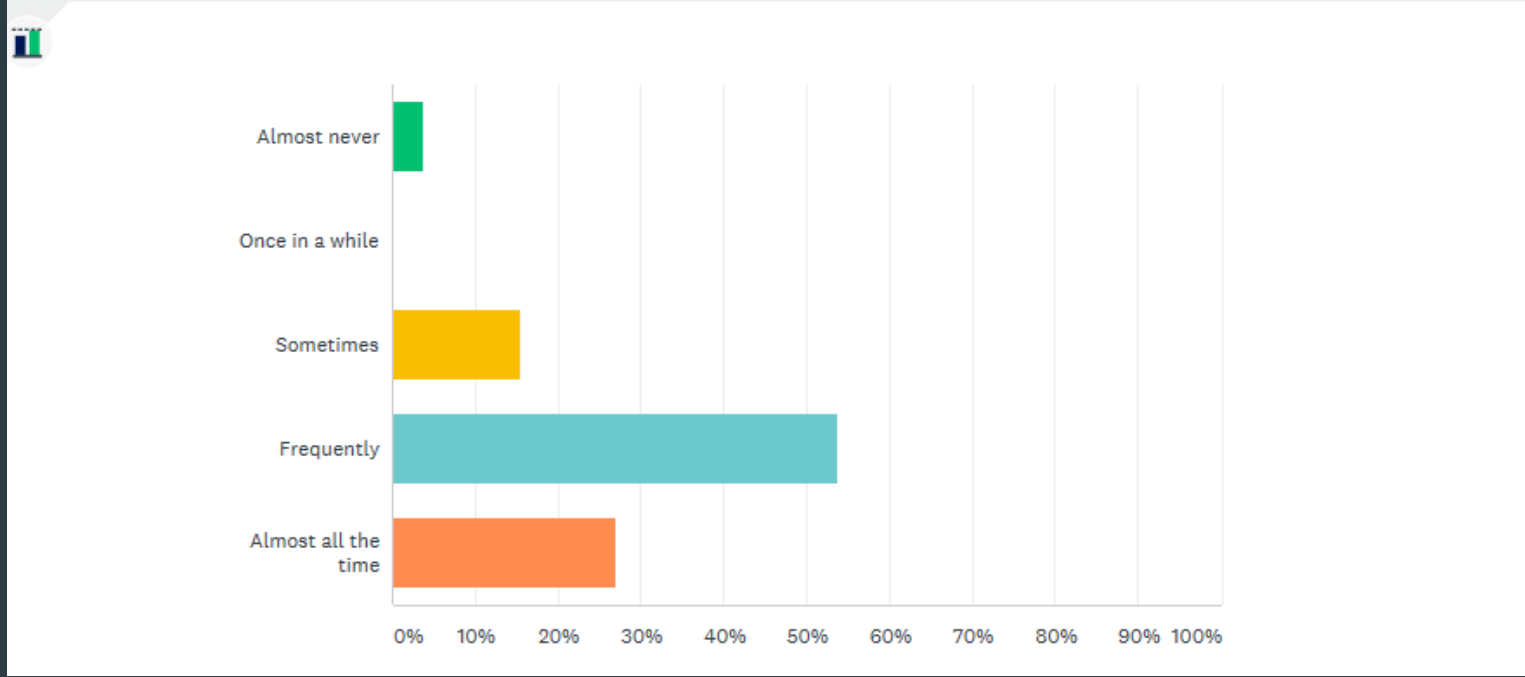

# How often do you have conversations with your child about what his or her class is learning at school?

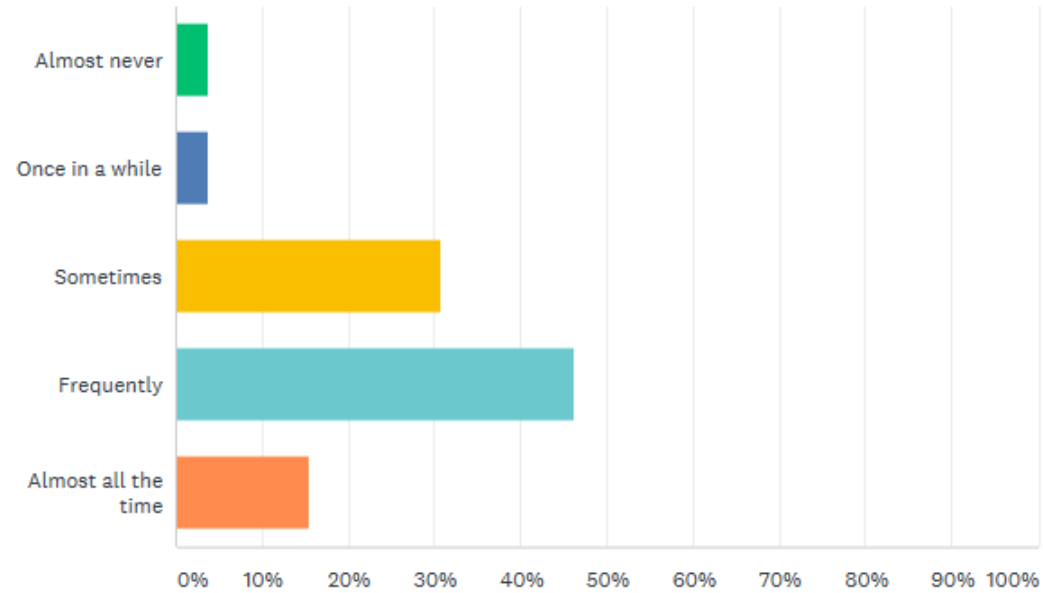

# How often do you help your child understand the content he or she is learning in school?

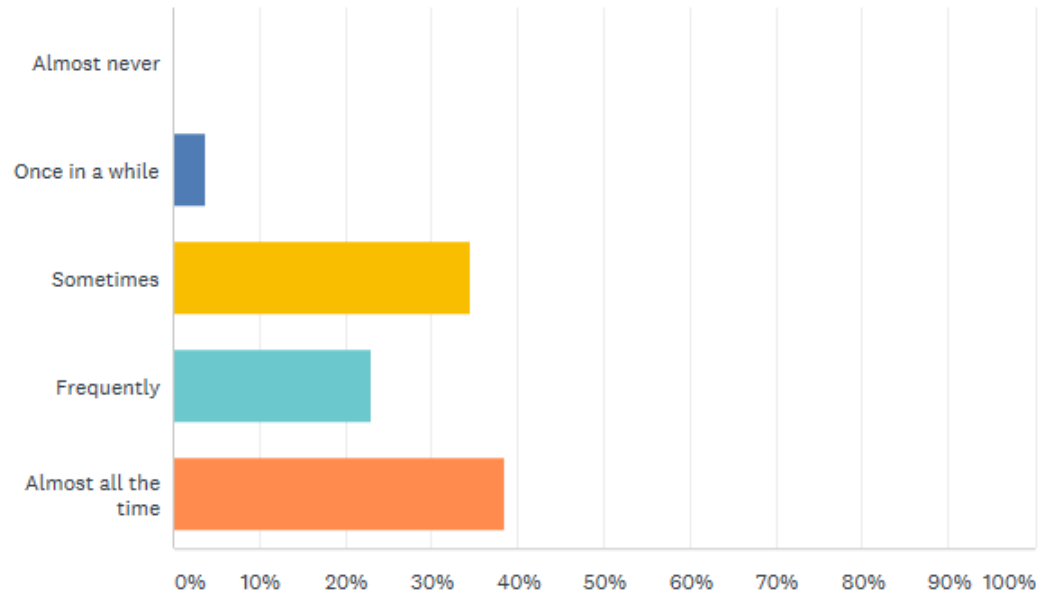

# How often do you help your child engage in activities which are educational outside the home?

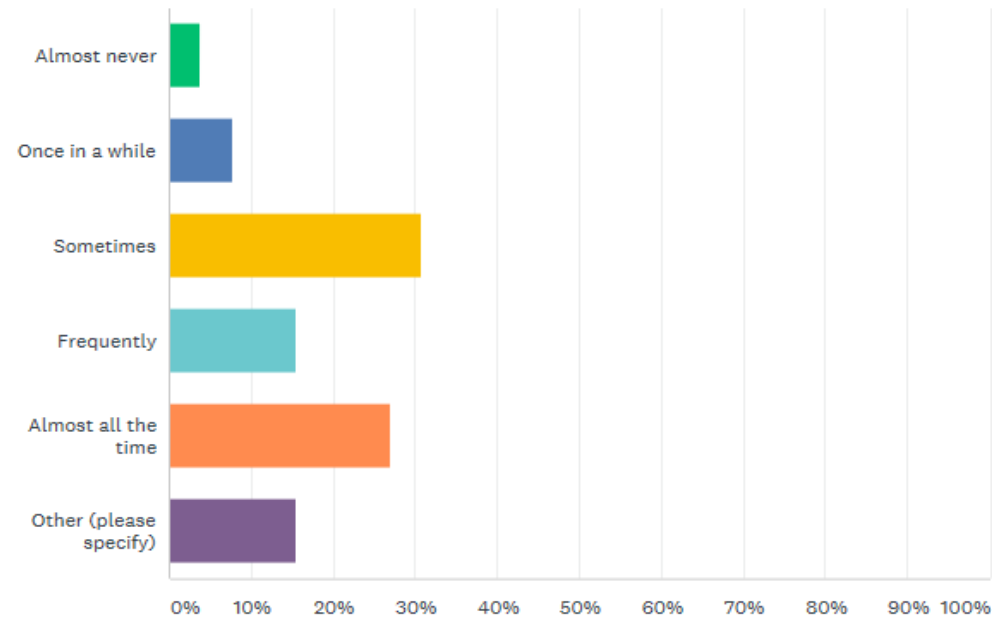

This has caused a lot of unnecessary stress in the home between us as parents and our child. This is even a gruesome fact that our child has an IEP and for some reason, we feel that there is a lack of following the IEP if our child is failing. So to answer this #6 question, we say "no", there is no communication from teacher to parent until after we receive the "bad news". MMS should create a better strategy on how this can be preventable for us and other families who may or may not have had this experience. We do not wish that any family have this unfortunate experience too!

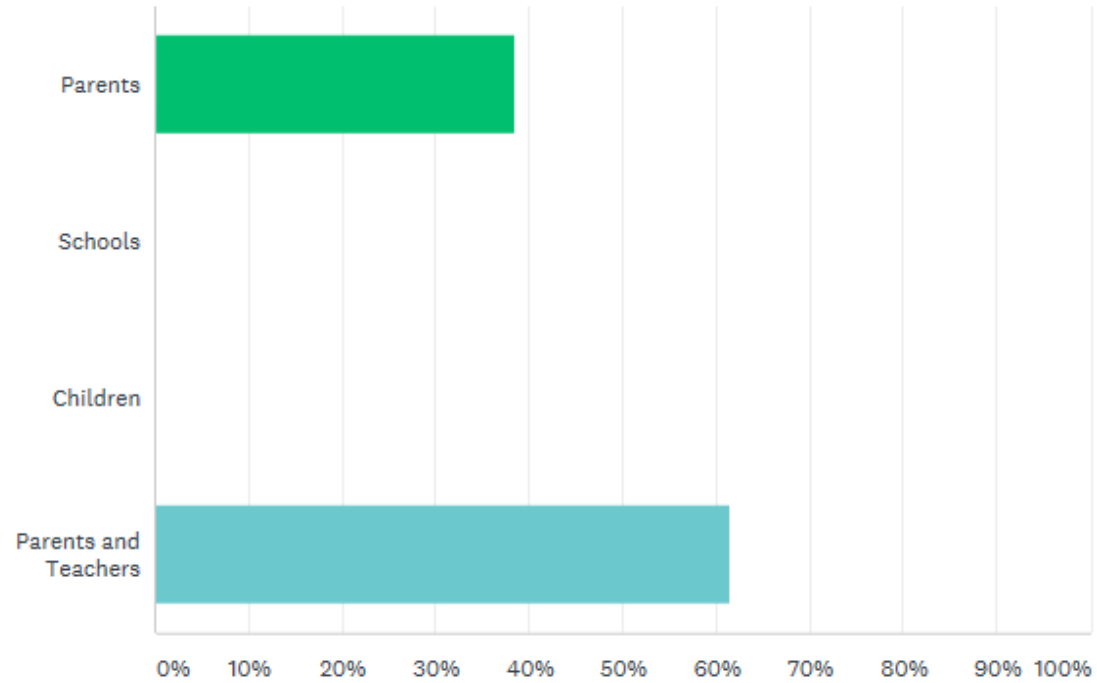

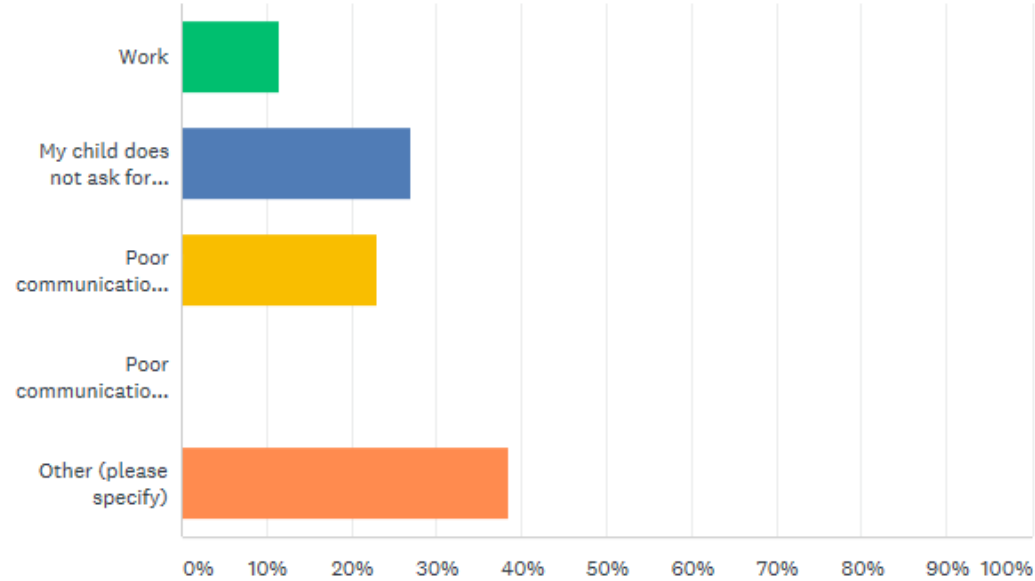

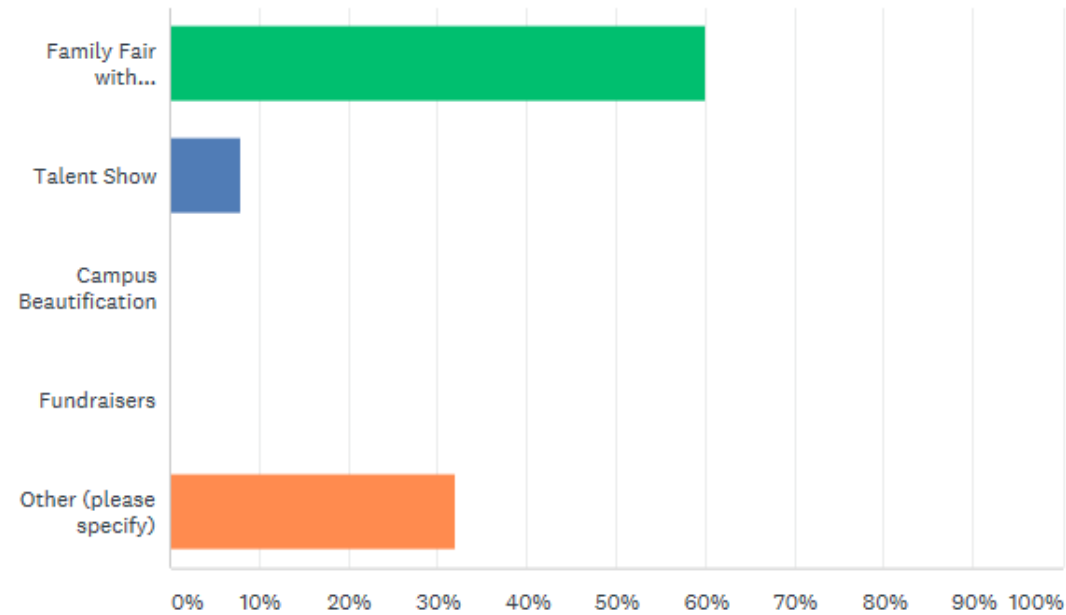
