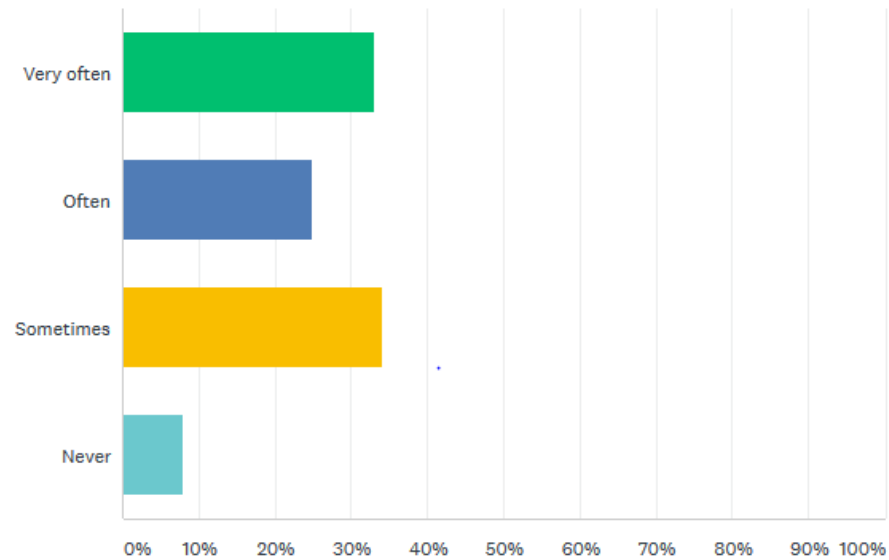


PCNC Student Survey

Research shows that Parent involvement with their children's school work boosts student achievement. How often does your parent/guardian help with your school work?

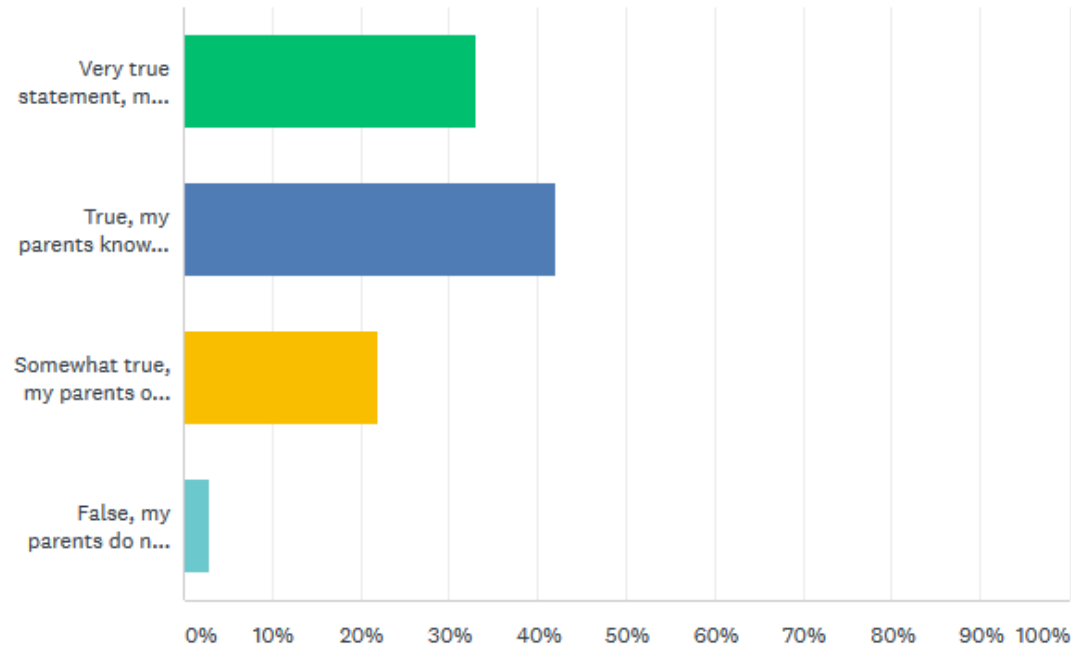

My parents/guardians have open communication with my teachers. They are well informed of my grades and how I am doing academically.

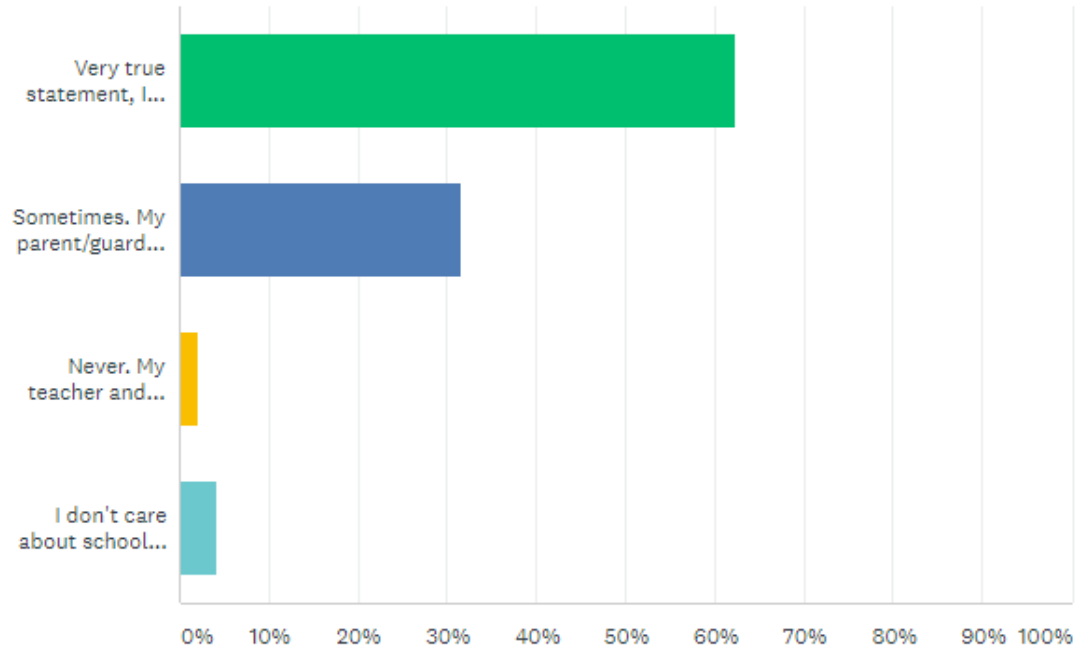

If I am failing in a particular subject, my parents are always aware. With the help of my teacher, they both provide me with the necessary resources to help me raise my grade and succeed.

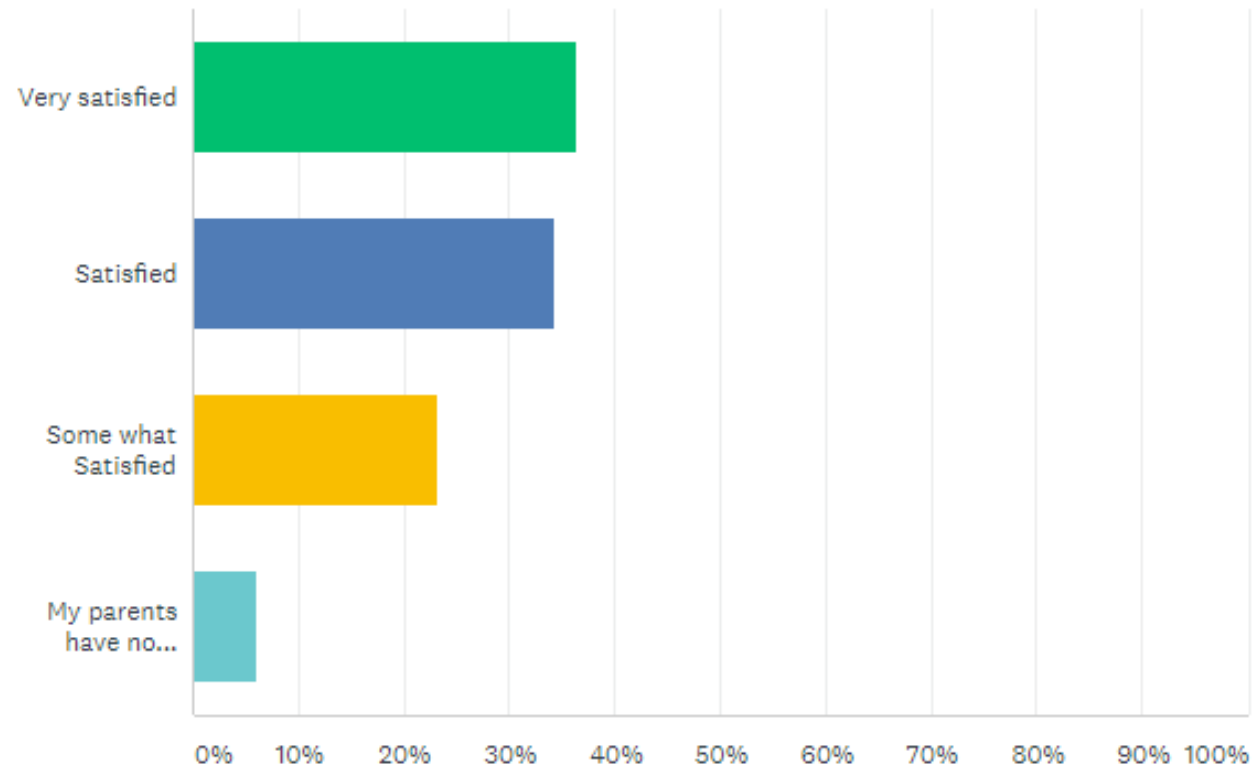

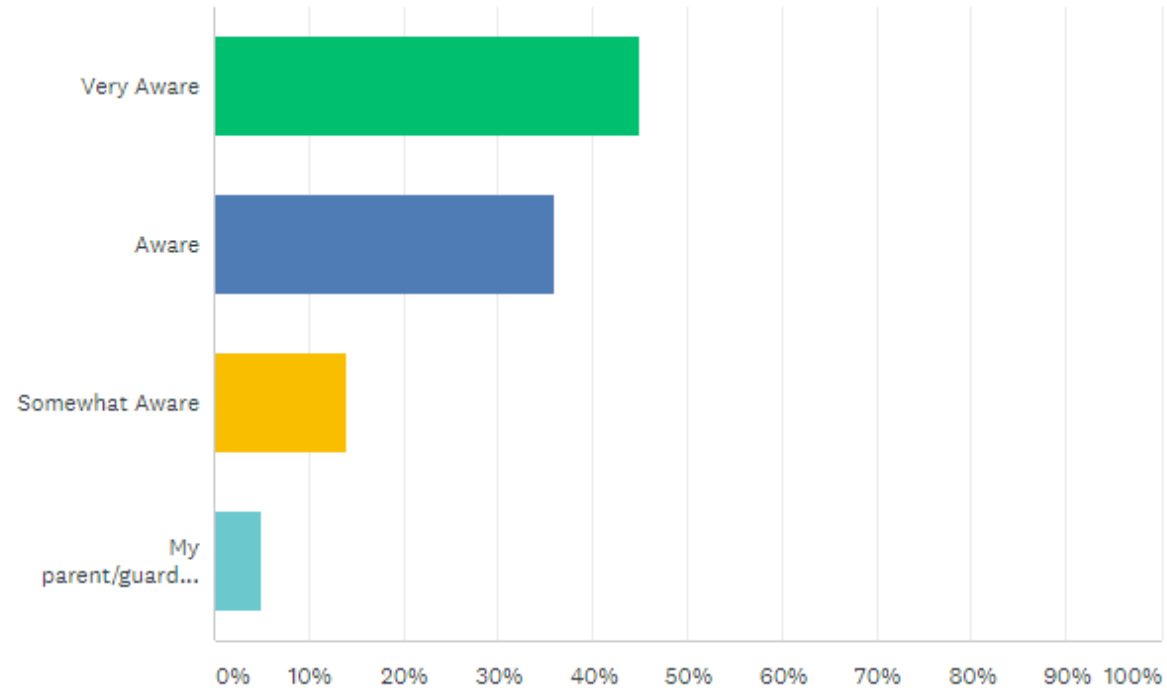

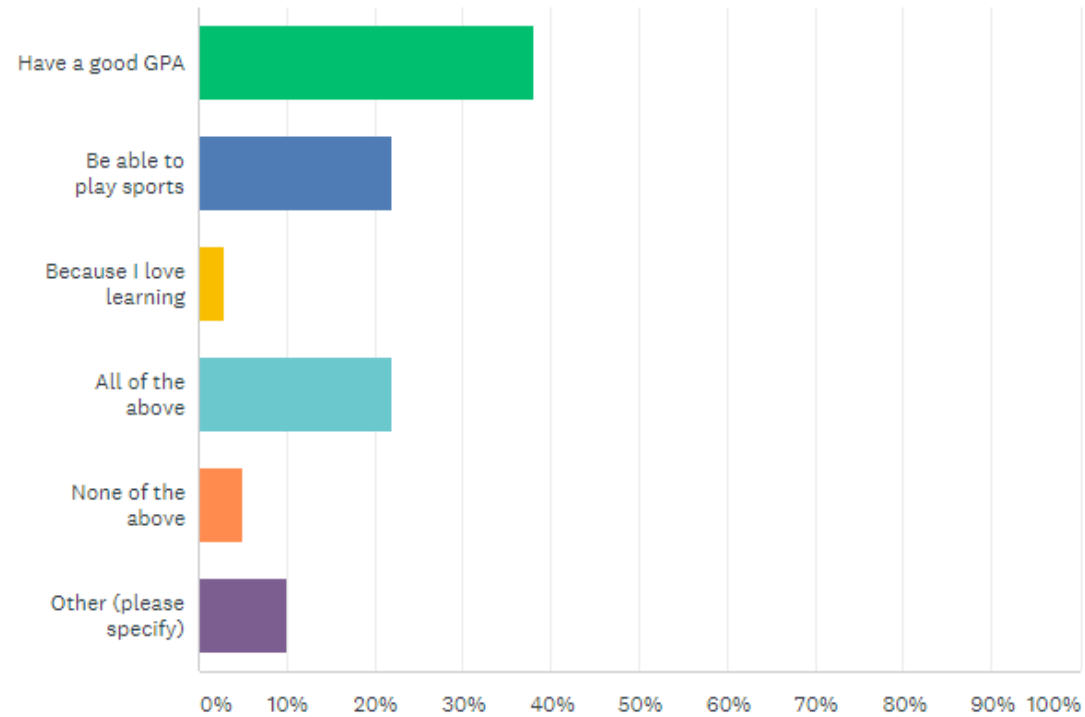
